Youth Services now offers a variety of non-traditional library items for check out, specifically targeted toward families and children.

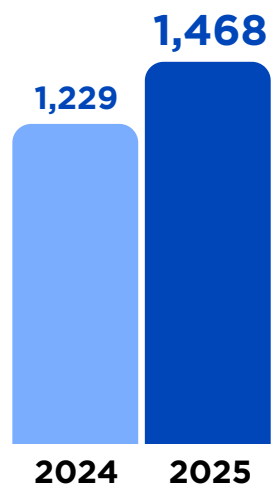

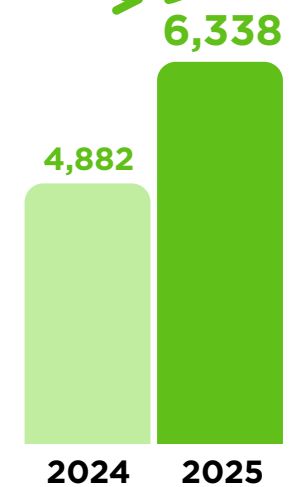

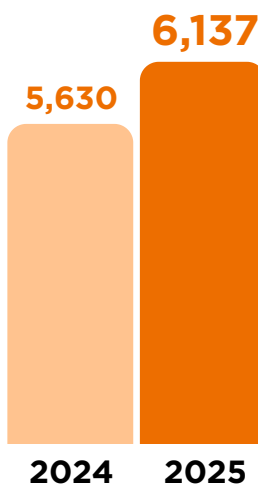

Our Collection

Marysville Public Library is a member of the Central Library Consortium (CLC) with 17 other libraries. Working together, this provides access to over 5 million items and over 1 million unique titles for our patrons.

59,322

items sent out to fill holds at other libraries

57,992

2,485,936

total physical items, downloadable audio and video, and ebook titles in our library collection.

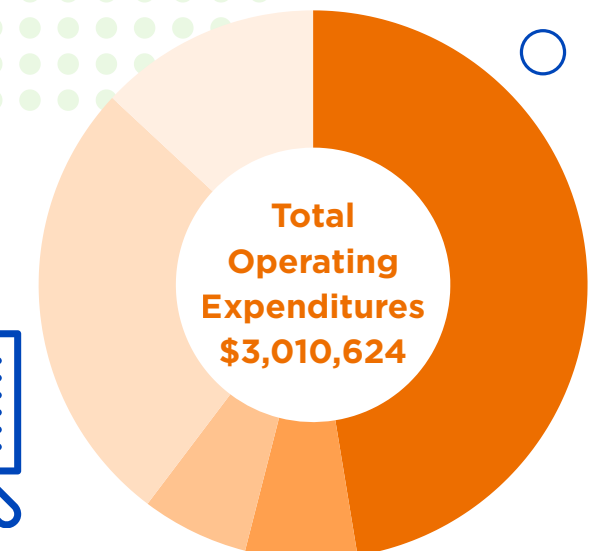
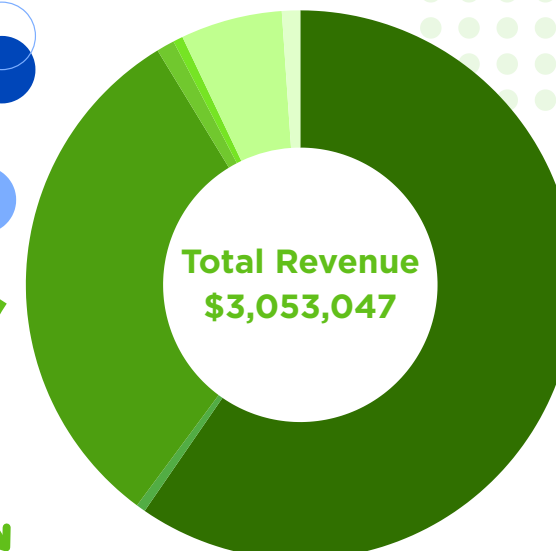
